Teaching Procedure

Activity #1: review #53 "Scoo Be Doo"

Create movements for song.

Practice in unison.

If students are successful in unison, try layering the ostinatos



Activity #2: Watch the class play "Scoo be Doo" on instruments

In this video, the class plays the ostinato parts on barred instruments.

They sing the chorus and add movements.

Sing along and copy the movements in the chorus.



Activity #3: Learn to play ostinatos 1-2 on a virtual xylophone

Read the notes together as a class

Activity #4: Virtual Xylophone

You can play the virtual xylophone by clicking a mouse, tapping on the bars on touch screen, or you can use the number keys.

Activity #9: Learn about Duke Ellington


